On May 4<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, 25<sup>th</sup> 2009, Jesus Jova was trained for a total of three days (10 hours). The training focused on HIV Antibody Testing techniques and exercises.

During the training, several HIV/AIDS educators/trainers from the P.A.C.E. Program, were introduced to the procedures involved with "Oraquick Advance: Rapid HIV1/2 Antibody Testing." Training began with an explicit breakdown of all components in the Orasure testing kit: Testing stand, Developer solution vial (1 milliliter), Test device including an absorbent packet.

Training continued with the proper removal of devices for testing purposes. After the peer educators successfully completed this section, we engaged the swabbing protocol involved. This was conducted with a "flat pad" demonstration, in order to secure oral mucosa transudate (O.M.T.) from the patient.

After educators were shown how to secure O.M.T., a comprehensive breakdown of how to read the results followed. The allotted amount of time that should and should not elapse, in order to obtain an accurate reading, was also emphasized during this section. P.A.C.E. educators/facilitators were then directed to the instruction packet inserted with the devices. The instruction packet, as explained, is a safety precaution against any misinterpretation of the test results.

This letter should serve as proof of completion (for P.A.C.E. facilitators/educators), where HIV antibody testing procedures and accompanying paperwork are concerned. The training lasted for three days over a course of ten hours. Any further questions about this training should be referred directly to me at the address below.


